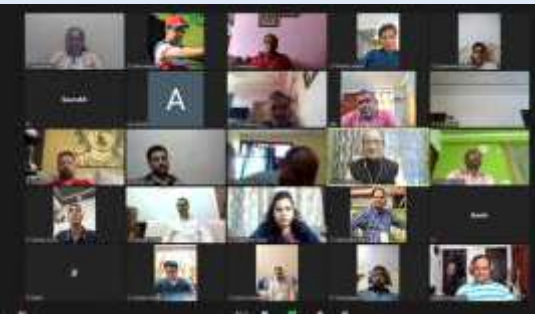
RECPDCL celebrates 14th Foundation Day

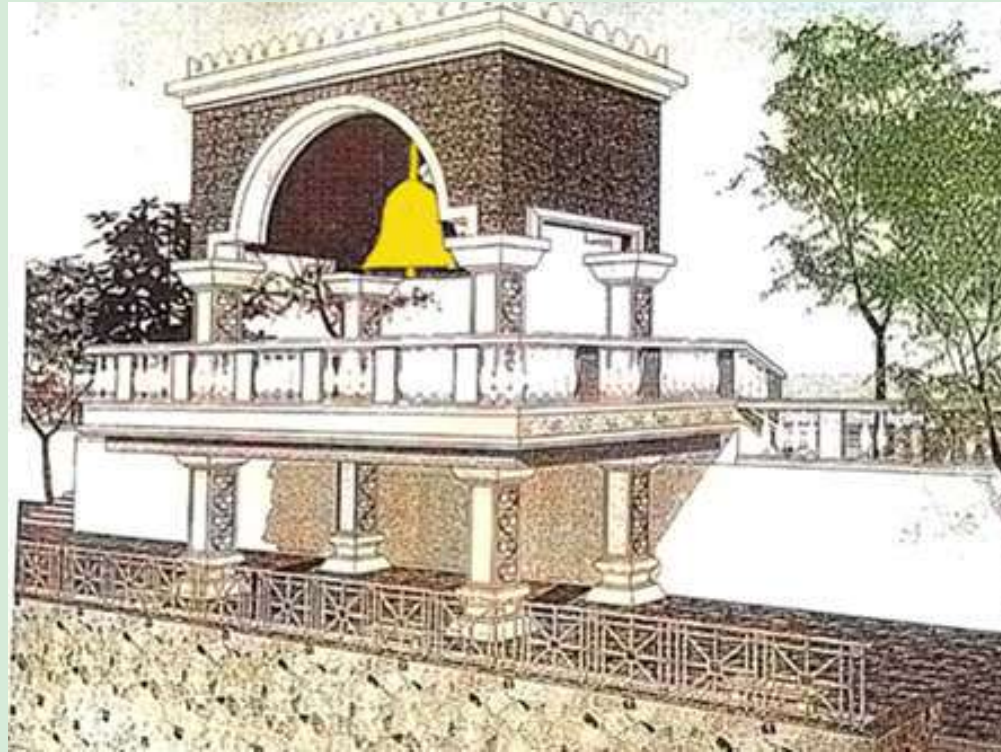
SJVN Unique initiative My Social Responsibility
